Additional Passages from last week’s Daily Scriptures:

Psalm 24; James 3; Hebrews 12:1-17; 1 Peter 1:13-25

- I. Pure in heart see God (Matthew 5:8)
 - A. Pure = Consistent throughout
 - B. Heart = Center of life
 - C. See = Understand, deeper knowledge

- II. Peacemakers are sons of God (Matthew 5:9)
 - A. Peacemaker = Calming influence
 - B. Secure in identity
 - C. God is a proud Father

- III. Pure minds are from children of God (1 John 3:1-10)
 - A. Self-disciplined in purity
 - B. Does not practice sin
 - C. Practices righteousness
