Be at peace with one another (Mark 9:50), love one another (John 13:34), be devoted to one another, honor one another (Romans 12:10), live in harmony with one another (Romans 12:16), accept one another (Romans 15:7), instruct one another (Romans 15:14), greet one another (Romans 16:16), serve one another (Galatians 5:13), carry each other's burdens (Galatians 6:2), be patient, bearing with one another in love (Ephesians 4:2), be kind and compassionate to one another forgiving each other just as God in Christ Jesus forgave you (Ephesians 4:32), in humility, consider others better than yourself (Philippians 2:3), teach one another, admonish one another (Galatians 3:16), encourage each other (1 Thessalonians 4:18), build each other up (1 Thessalonians 5:11), spur one another on toward love and good deeds (Hebrews 10:24), do not slander one another (James 4:11), don't grumble against each other (James 5:9), confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another (James 5:16)!
