- C. Jesus cleansed the woman because of her faith

III. Jairus, Ruler of the Synagogue (49-56)

- A. Risked his position by hanging around Jesus
- B. He had faith that Jesus could heal his daughter
- C. Do we have that kind of faith in Jesus?
