Additional Passages from last week’s Daily Scriptures:

Genesis 46-50; Exodus 1-4

- I. Moses was keeping the wrong flock (3:1-6)
 - A. He ran away from Egypt
 - B. He could not run from God
 - C. He recognized God’s voice

- II. God chose Moses to save His people (3:7-12)
 - A. He did not give up on Moses
 - B. He heard the prayers of His people
 - C. God is never out of reach

- III. Moses was not ready for the task (3:13-22, 4:1-17)
 - A. He was a self-fulfilling prophecy
 - B. God revealed His plan to Moses
 - C. God refused to let Moses quit
