 - A. Saved his parents from a lion
 - B. Killed 30 men from the town
 - C. Used a jawbone of a donkey to kill 1,000 men

- III. Became weak but finished strong (Judges 16)
 - A. Samson gave into Delilah's nagging
 - B. He was captured and tortured
 - C. God granted his final request
