 - A. 2 level government for transition to Persian Empire

 - A. Daniel just prayed like he always did
 - B. The King did not want to punish Daniel
 - C. The officials forced the King’s hand

- III. Punishment and Protection of the Prophet (16-28)
 - A. Daniel was thrown into the Lions’ Den
 - B. God protected Daniel and the King was relieved
 - C. The King proclaimed Daniel’s God is to be feared
